Print To Me is FabSoft's secure release printing solution. Print To Me allows users to send their document to the print queue and print it out whenever the document is needed.

Print To Me provides users with an extra layer of security as each document is password protected. Documents will only be printed when the user logs in to the MFP with the user name and password provided once the document is sent to the MFP. This feature also eliminates confidential documents and other paperwork from being printed by accident, or left behind at the MFP. By being password protected, the Print To Me solution helps the environment by decreasing paper waste and over printing drastically.



If there is heavy user traffic, a paper jam or an offline MFP, users can move to another network connected MFP to print out their documents.

- Print information is information transferred to Main SQL Database
- Print jobs are transferred to the Reform Server.
- · Release information is sent from any of the Reform PDC service to the Print To Me Agents

#### For example:

- 1. User 1 prints a 10MB Document
- 2. Print Job Data & Information is sent to the Main Data Location
- 3. The user requests the document from MOST on the MFP
- 4. Print Job Information is released from the Main Location
- 5. Print Server releases the print job and prints the document to the MFP
